OUR STORY

The name Ki'Lala means "butterfly" in the she shashishalhem language of the Shíshálh Nation. To honour my daughters, who are connected to the Shíshálh Nation, I chose a word from their language as the name of my company.

The butterfly represents my granddaughter's spirit—transformation, beauty, and the opportunity to grow, inspire, and create something meaningful.

It reminds me of her.



I chose the color purple because it holds deep meaning for me. It represents wisdom, spirituality, healing, and resilience. In our teachings, it is a symbol of the healing power of the grandmothers, a reminder of justice, and the strength we carry through love, culture, and connection.

Ki'Lala Events & Décor was founded to create authentic Indigenous environments that celebrate culture, honour community, and showcase the extraordinary work of Indigenous artists. Every gathering is an opportunity to tell a story, strengthen relationships, and create spaces where people feel welcomed, respected, and inspired.

DESCRIPTION

Our Sacred Ancestor Welcome Panels are designed to respectfully welcome guests as they enter an event, creating an immediate connection to the land, culture, and community hosting the gathering.

One panel displays the word "Welcome" in English, while the companion panel is customized with the traditional welcome of the Nation whose territory the event is being held on. Whether on Musqueam, Lekwungen, Squamish, Tsleil-Waututh, Nisga'a or another Nation's territory, the language is respectfully adapted to honour the local hosts and acknowledge their lands.

Each ancestor wears a handcrafted cedar bark headdress trimmed with abalone and mother-of-pearl buttons, reflecting the beauty and significance of Northwest Coast traditions.

These panels are most often positioned at entrances, greeting guests with dignity, respect, and a sense of belonging before they enter the gathering space.

One panel displays the word "Welcome" in English, while the companion panel is customized with the traditional welcome in the language of the host Nation. Whether your event is held on Musqueam, Kwakwaka'wakw, Lekwungen, Squamish, Tsleil-Waututh, or another Indigenous territory, the welcome changes to reflect and honour the people whose land you are on.

Featuring a precision-cut CNC Bear and Wolf design by Kwakwaka'wakw artist Brent Smith, these panels represent strength, protection and hospitality while bringing the natural beauty of cedar into any space.

These panels look exceptional at any entrance or behind a registration table, providing guests with an immediate sense of welcome, respect, and connection from the moment they arrive.

Standing 10.6 feet high, the panels can be displayed together to frame a stage or separately to create balance throughout a venue. During the day, their bold red and black artwork commands attention with rich detail and powerful form. In the evening, subtle uplighting transforms the panels into an even more dramatic feature, adding depth, warmth, and atmosphere.

For an authentic finishing touch, we often style the panels with cedar trees, ferns, or other natural greenery, bringing the beauty of the outdoors into your event space while complementing the artwork.

Raised in Hazelton by his mother and three older sisters within the Gitxsan matrilineal tradition, family and culture have always been at the heart of his journey.

As a young boy spending time with his father in the village of Kispiox, Timothy was introduced to the late Walter E. Harris, O.C. and his carving studio, "The Hiding Place." The scent of cedar and the masterful artistry of Gitxsan carvers sparked a passion that continues to guide his path.

Timothy's work honours the teachings, stories, and visual language of his ancestors, sharing the beauty and strength of Gitxsan art with the world.



CARMEN PAOLA REDUNANTE

NISGA'A | TSIMSHIAN | CHILEAN INDIGENOUS HERITAGE

Carmen Paola Redunante is a developing Indigenous artist whose heritage reflects the rich cultures of the Northwest Coast and Chile. Her father's family is Nisga'a from the village of Gingolx, and her paternal grandfather is Tsimshian from Lax Kw'alaams.

Carmen is deeply passionate about the environment and uses her art to share beauty, cultural teachings, and hidden messages. She hopes to raise awareness about preserving our forests, animals, and water for future generations.

Her artwork often honours the salmon—one of the most vital beings of the Northwest Coast. Carmen speaks of the salmon's journey from the ocean to the rivers, where it sustains the people, animals, and land, and teaches us respect. *"When we witness the beauty around us, we give thanks to the salmon for completing its sacred cycle."*
